

Dear Family and Friends of Sacred Heart Catholic School;

Thank you so much for your overwhelming response to our mum fundraiser! Thanks to you we have over 550 mums being delivered tomorrow!

We have had to put extra thought into the distribution process in order to have them all picked up promptly and not interfere with dismissal! Please pay attention to the procedure we have outlined below.

Please enter from the Cleveland Street entrance (back parking lot) and circle around as directed. You will then be able to continue around to the front of the school to pick up your child(ren). Please arrive 15 minutes earlier than you normally would for dismissal, if possible.

We had several families with very large orders. Thank you! We will have your orders separated from the rest of the plants, so when you send your customers to us, please have them mention your name and we will direct them to their orders.

It is going to be a little bit hectic at first, so please be patient with us. Our goal is to keep dismissal running as smoothly as possible and making sure we are accurate with our flower distribution. There are not any extras, so the orders have to be precise. If one person drives away with the wrong plant, it will throw off the orders. We sure do appreciate your cooperation!
