Kami is a program that lets you write, highlight, type, and record on top of a PDF.


How to open your work with Kami:

1. Open Google Classroom:


2. Go to your Teacher's Class:




3. Click the assignment your teacher made:




4. Click the PDF activity in your assignment:

6. Click Annotate with Kami:





What can Kami do?

The Select tool- lets you click or highlight things.

The Dictionary – Look up words on the page


Mark up allows you to highlight, underline or cross out text on your page.

Comment will let you record your voice, a video, or a picture of your screen.






The Text tool allows you to add a text box anywhere on the page so you can type answers on the assignment. The number controls the size of the letter you type.



The Equation Tool allows you to type math symbols and other tricky math operations like fractions or exponents.



The Draw tool allows you to draw on your page.




The Shape tool allows you to add lines and shapes to your page.

The Erase tool allows you to erase Kami changes

The Media tool allows you to add files from your computer or Google Drive.

The save options are important!
